

Discover Nepal

Day 01:

Upon arrival in Kathmandu, clients will be greeted at the airport by a Kathmandu Travels & Tours representative offering of a "Khada", a religious Buddhist silk scarf, and transferred to your hotel. Rest of the day free.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel Marshyangdi.

Day 02:

AM: Kathmandu city and Swoyambhunath: Tour of Kathmandu city also called the "City of Glory". Visit includes, Durbar Square, Kasthamandap, said to be constructed from a single piece wood. Kumari Ghar Home to the World's only living Goddess and Hanuman Dhoka Palace. Once a year, during Indra Jatra festival, the King of Nepal seeks the Kumari's blessing. A short visit to Bhairab, the God of destruction and Taleju Temple, built in 1549 AD. Thereafter visit Swoyambunath Stupa, said to be one of the oldest Buddhist Stupas in the World, which is majestically set high on a Hill overlooking Kathmandu Valley. It is nicknamed as the monkey temple after the tribe of monkeys that look after the hill and often amuses the visitors.

PM: Tour of Patan, the "City of Fine Arts". Durbar Square, Krishna Temple, Hiranyavarna Mahavira, the Golden Temple of Lord Buddha and the Tibetan Handcrafts Center. Dinner and overnight at Hotel Marshyangdi.

Day 03:

AM: Bhaktapur city. Bhaktapur, the "City of Devotees" where you will meander down narrow lanes past centuries old homes and temples. The tour will begin with a visit to Durbar Square, the Golden Gate, Palace of 55 windows, Lion's Gate. The Nyatapola Temple, the tallest of its kind in Nepal, Bhairab Temple, the Pottery Center and Dattraya Temple.

PM: Pashupatinath & Boudhanath. Tour of Pasupatinath, a Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva. This massive complex sits alongside the banks of the holy Bagmati River only Hindus are allowed to enter the courtyard of the temple, whereas tourists can see the temple from the eastern side of the Bagmati River. Afterwards, visit Boudanath, a Buddhist Stupa said to be one of the largest in the world. This structure stands tall with four pairs of eyes each facing the four cardinal directions, watching for righteous mankind and for human prosperity. Dinner and overnight at Hotel Marshyangdi.

Day 04:

AM: After breakfast at the Hotel, transfer to domestic airport and fly Kathmandu-Bharatpur, upon arrival transfer to lodge. Lunch at lodge.

PM: Jungle activities like elephant safari, nature walk etc.

Dinner and overnight at Safari Narayani Lodge.

Day 05:

Full day jungle activities like elephant safari. canoe ride, bird watching etc.

Lunch, dinner and overnight at Safari Narayani Lodge.

Day 06:

After breakfast at the lodgel, drive to Pokhara (approx 6 hrs) and transfer to hotel.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel Kantipur.

Day 07:

AM: Transfer to Naudanda and hike up to Sarangkot, which lets the trekkers enjoy an eye feast of the Annapurna range to the north and overlook Phewa Tal (Lake) and the valley of Pokhara to the south and east.

PM: Half-day sightseeing tour of Pokhara. Sightseeing tour includes an hour boating at Phewa lake, visits to Bindyabashini Temple, Seti Gorge, The Bazaar, Devi's Fall.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel Kantipur.

Day 08:

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to airport and fly Pokhara-Kathmandu, upon arrival meet and transfer to hotel.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel Marshyangdi.

Day 09:

Free day in Kathmandu (option, Mountain flight).

Dinner and overnight at Hotel Marshyangdi.

Day 10:

Transfer to international airport to connect the flight for onward journey.
